# Healthy Brain, Healthy Kid: terms and conditions

### 1. Introduction

- 1.1. These terms and conditions govern the course "Healthy Brain, Healthy Kid" ('The Course'), as written and delivered by Dr MaryAnne Shiozawa, and offered by Quirkafleeg Ltd.
